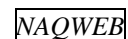

Frequently Asked Questions

What form of payments do you accept? For advance reservations we can accept the major credit cards, checks, money orders, or purchase orders.

What is a Wacky Quacker? Wacky Quackers are noisemakers in the shape of a duck bill. Not just for kids, Wacky Quackers are a fun way to participate in the experience of your tour!

How long is your season? Weather-dependending, the Ducks run from late April to early November

How many people can fit on a duck? Each Duck can hold 37 people and a maximum of 2 Ducks can run at once.

How long is the tour? The standard Duck tour is 45 minutes long.

What will we see on the tour? On the Ducks you will explore the waterfronts of Newport, Covington and Cincinnati and enjoy such sites as the World Peace Bell, Historic Riverside Drive, Great American Ballpark, and Paul Brown Stadium.

Where can I pick up my group tickets? You can pick up your group tickets at the Newport on the Levee Welcome Center (located on the upper level of the Levee in front of the Newport Aquarium).

When should I arrive for my tour? You should arrive at least 30 minutes in advance of your tour departure time to pick-up your tickets and line up for boarding. All seating is general admission - two to a seat. Tours depart promptly on time.

What happens if someone misses the tour? All tickets are non-refundable, non-exchangeable tickets. Please be sure everyone is able to arrive 30 minutes in advance of your scheduled tour before purchasing tickets.

Where do I park? The closest parking is available at Newport on the Levee and can range in pricing depending on day and time. For more information on parking please contact Parking Solutions at 859-291-4624.

Are food and drinks allowed on board? Only water is allowed on board.

Will I get wet? If you are afraid of getting wet avoid the window seats in the rows and also the last row of seats on the Ducks. These seats are more likely to have a chance of getting wet. The tours depart rain or shine. There is a roof to cover the vehicle and there are windows that can be rolled down for inclement weather.

Is Ride the Ducks handicap accessible? Yes. Each Duck can accommodate 1 wheelchair (this takes seating down to 34 people per Duck).

Is there a restroom on board the Duck? No, but public restrooms are available at Newport on the Levee.

Can small children Ride the Ducks? Yes. Ride the Ducks is great fun for children of all ages as well as the young at heart! Because the inside of the Duck is similar to the inside of a school bus and there are no seatbelts, car seats are also not required. We recommend parents hold small children in their lap. Remember, everyone needs a ticket to board, so don't forget to mention your little ones under two years of age for a free ticket! Unfortunately, strollers cannot be taken onboard, but we'd be happy to store it for the duration of your tour. *Ride the Ducks of Newport is not responsible for items left in our ticket booth for the duration of the tour.*

Are the Ducks Coast Guard certified? Yes. Each year all our vessels are thoroughly inspected by the United States Coast Guard and issued a Certificate of Inspection. Plus, all our Captains are Coast Guard-certified with at least a 25-ton Master's license.

Are life vests on board? Yes. We are required by law to keep life vests onboard for all our guests, as well as emergency equipment in case of an emergency.
